

QUALITY

Our particle-filtering respirator masks (FFP2/EN 149 and EN 14683) meet the highest criteria for legally prescribed hygiene guidelines. When developing our machine, we collaborated with renowned organisations, including the RWTH Aachen Institute of Textile Technology (ITA), the Protect Institute (Siegen University) and Weber Ultrasonics.



W QUANTITY

Our high-performance custom mask production machine, which we developed in-house, has an output of 360 masks per minute. With three production lines, we are able to manufacture and individually pack around 90 million respirator masks per year.



AVAILABILITY

Thanks to our technological expertise in custom machine construction, we are able to minimise our machine downtime. As a result, our production performance rate is an impressive 98 per cent.

We started developing our mask at the beginning of the pandemic, with the clear goal of creating a safe and high-quality mask. One of our biggest aspirations in the development process was to make a mask that is 100% Made in Germany.
